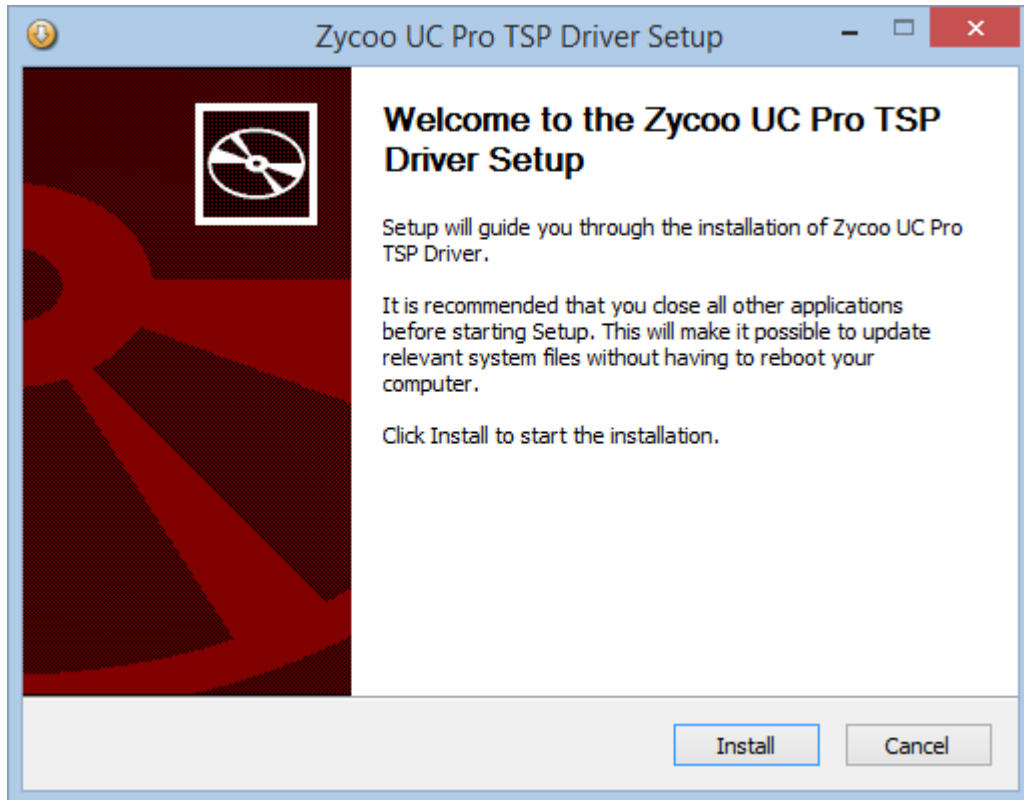

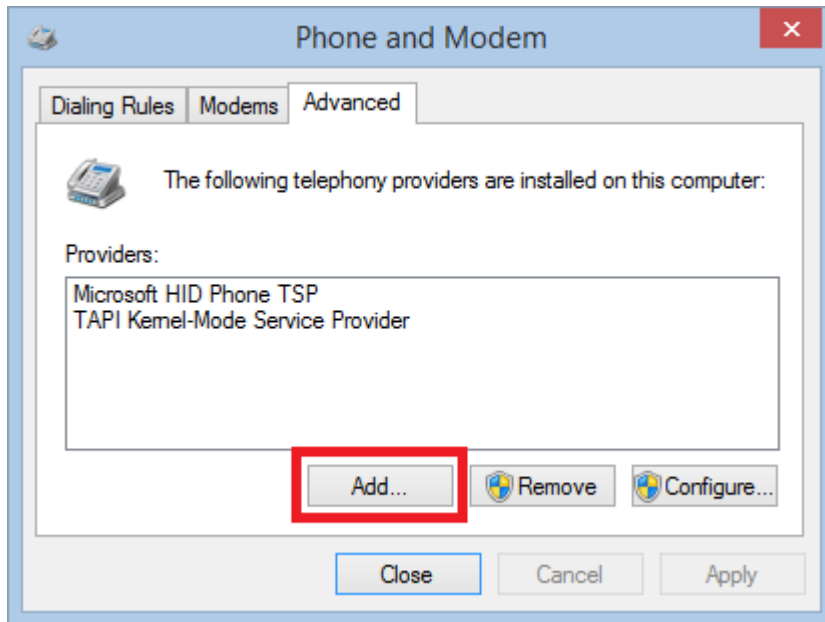
Installing and Configuring the UC Pro TSP Driver

This document will guide you through the process of Installing and configuring the UC Pro TSP Driver.

Launch UC Pro TSP Driver Installer.



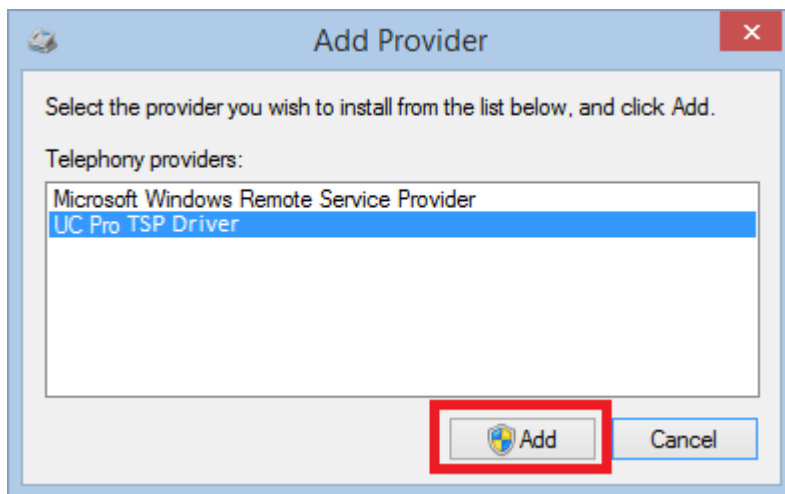
Click "Install" and wait for the installation to finish.



Navigate to "Control Panel\All Control Panel Items\Phone and Modem".

Go to the "Advanced" tab.

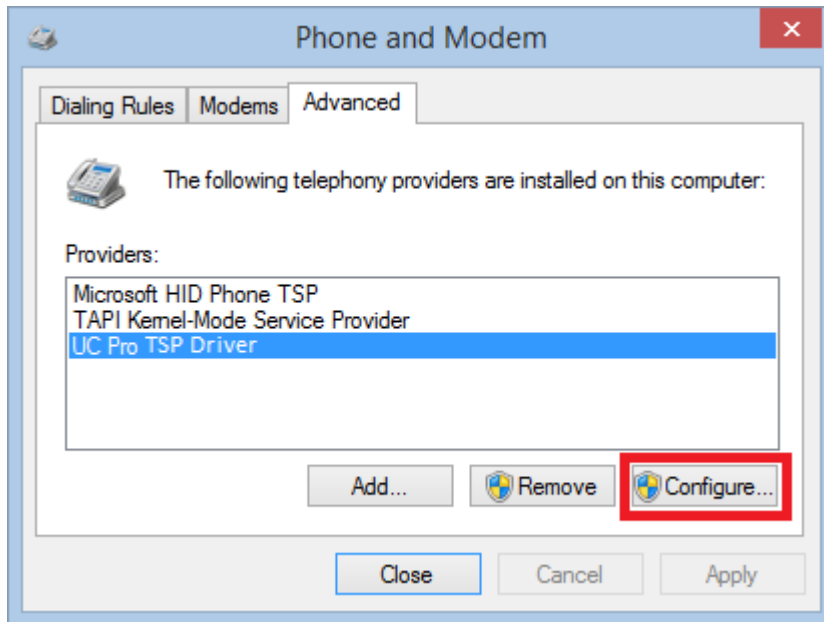
Click "Add".



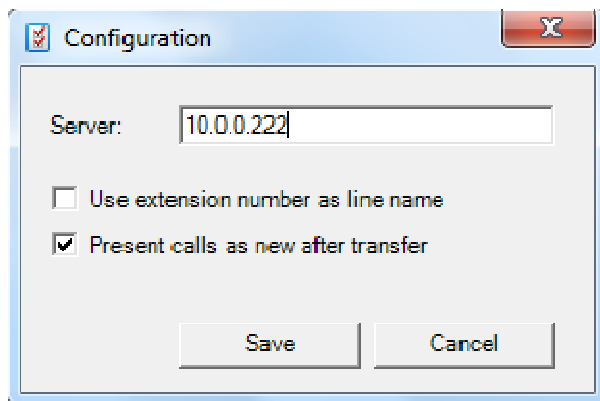
Select UC Pro TSP Driver.

Click "Add".

Restart PC for changes to take effect.



You must now open the "Phone and Modem" options again and select "Configure" against the "UCPro TSP Driver".



In the last stage, you will be prompted with the driver configuration window.

In the "Server" field, enter server address of the UC Server*.

You have also two options to select from:

1. If you would like to "Use extension number as line name" which is turned off by default.
This option is designed for applications that present the "line name" as a list of extensions to select. Users may prefer the extension number to be shown there instead.
2. If you would like to "Present calls as new after transfer".
Some applications may not be written to handle call transfers correctly (data changes on call) so, as an option, the driver can present those as a new call.



Once you are done configuring the driver, click "Save". In order to dial telephone numbers, make sure that the extension information is configured on the third party application.

** If you do not know your UC Server IP address, contact your telephone system maintainer.*
